* **LEARNING CENTER WORKSHOP** Tuesdays, 9:00 - 10:30 am (ages: high school)
For full time enrolled students. We will work on the student's portfolio, resume', college applications, scholarships and grants, etc.

* **LIFE PRACTICUM** Tuesdays 10:30 am - 12:00 pm (ages: high school)
A required course for Academy Northwest students, it covers relationships, developing character, preparing for adulthood, career planning, personal finance, career exploration, and digital literacy. Course written by Academy NW and uses additional books and resources.

* **CHEMISTRY and LAB** Tuesdays, 2:30 - 4:00 pm (ages: high school)
Study atomic theory, chemical composition, chemical reactions, balancing chemical equations, gas laws, thermodynamics, and more! Students will use the online lessons and do labs together as well as write lab reports. Pre-requisite: Bob Jones Physical Science. Curriculum: *Discovering Design With Chemistry* (Berean Builders), workbook, Life of Fred Chemistry. Scientific calculator, lab coat and goggles required. \$50 lab fee

* **CIVICS** Tuesdays, 12:30 - 2:00 pm (ages: high school)
Study the United States Constitution and Government through the Hillsdale College Online Courses. Meets the high school graduation requirement.

PERSONAL FINANCE Tuesdays, 10:30 - 12:00 pm (ages: high school)
Foundations in Personal Finance by Dave Ramsey, *Make Your Paycheck Last* by Harold Moe, H&R Block curriculum, and other resources.

* **GEOMETRY**(age: high school, pre-requisite: Algebra 1)
There will not be a class, but tutoring is available
Curriculum: Jacobs Geometry (DVDs are optional, but recommended) and Life of Fred.

INDEPENDENT STUDY CLASSES are available in other subjects, such as PE, Health, Pacific NW History or Washington State History, etc. These can be taken for high school credit. Students can enroll part time for 1 credit/semester

BJU ONLINE COURSES are available for many other subjects, including English (Grammar & Literature), History (US and World), Sciences, Math, and Bible. These can be taken for high school credit.
